

A letter received from John Roberts, 10-8-05.

Bob

Thanks for calling! Yes, the hurricane (Katrina) hit here. Some, but not us. Lucky! Live 7 to 8 miles from the coast, but have a Bayou next door. We are on a bluff (Martin bluff) with a hillside in back. Maybe 60 Ft. to a ditch which empties into Bayou Castille 75 ft. west of our boundary line. Water from the storm surge reached within 10 ft of our sun room which is on piers. It came within 6 ft. of the house

Thanks to all who were not affected, we had four semi trailers, as well as dozens of vans, large and small, to unload goods at our church for those less fortunate than us. Our church had minor roof damage. Roofing off several rooms and much pine tree debris. Many of our members lost all, many lost much, but God is good and the people are optimistic.

Our new house is just right. Two bedrooms, sun room, 2 baths, etc.
